4) *CSS:*

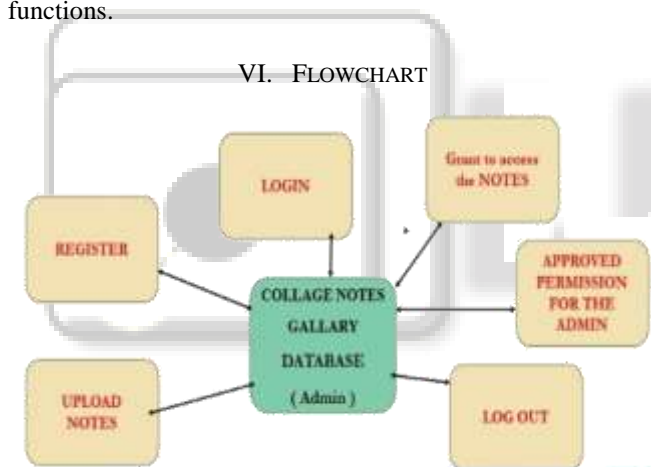
CSS is cascading style sheet which is used to give designer look to HTML using the external file.
